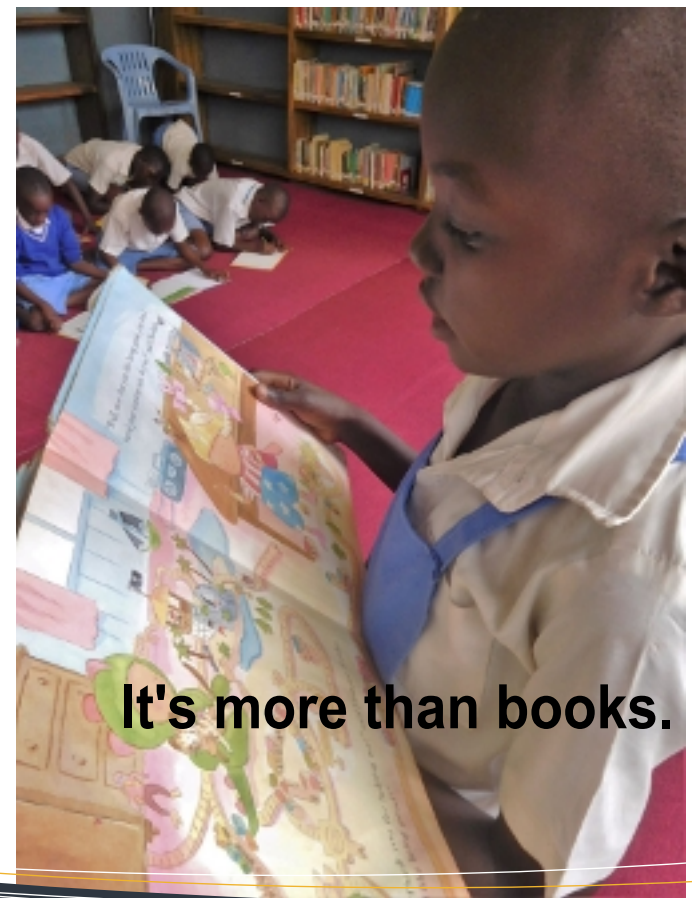

What Makes Libraries of Love Unique

- Since 2005, 94,000 young people have passed through schools with Libraries of Love libraries.
- At present, over 47,000 students are enjoying literature from their libraries.
- 15,000 hardback books are shipped annually, prepared with spine labels and pockets and cards.
- Libraries are restocked as books are worn or lost.
- Each summer travel volunteers help organize new libraries and restock established libraries.
- 40 students have sponsors that pay for school fees, food, uniforms, shoes, and backpacks.
- 7 sponsored students have graduated from college, and 1 is attending currently.
- A daily free lunch program is in place at Libraries of Love's most disadvantaged school.

HOW DO WE DO IT?

Libraries of Love collects hardback new or like new books. The books are prepared with spine labels. Pockets and cards are added for borrowing. A container is shipped to Uganda. A team of volunteers then travels to Uganda, where it takes an empty room in a school, unpacks, and arranges the thousands of books in library order. The teachers and students are then trained in the use of their library.

A LIFETIME PARTNERSHIP

Libraries of Love's Executive Director, Trudy Marshall, lives in Uganda six months each year. She visits each library often and holds training seminars for the librarians and headmasters. When she is in the States, trained Ugandan personnel continue her work in the libraries.

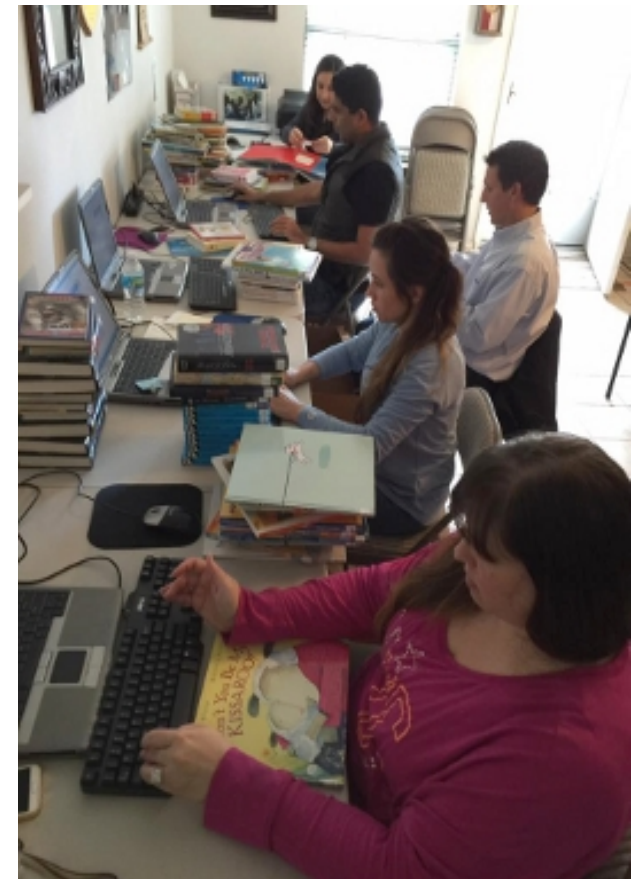
